- Oral thrush (white tongue)

- Estrogen/progesterone imbalance, diminishing hormones
- Swollen and tender lymph nodes in the breast area, underarms
- Tingling or numbness in the arms and legs
- Burning pain around the chest wall or breasts
- Cold and discolored hands and feet
- Foul body odor
- Muscle twitching
- Vertigo
- Fevers
- Dehydration
- Frequent urination
- Chronic neck and back pain
- Photosensitivity
- Nail changes (cracking, splitting, slow growth, etc.)
- Skin freckling, pigmentation changes (darkening or white spots)
- Edema (swelling) around eyes
- Premature aging
- Decline in vision or vision disturbances
- Slow muscle recovery after activity
- Liver and kidney dysfunction
- Gastrointestinal and digestive issues
